


Hello Everyone,

There's a cool nip in the air, the geese are migrating, and the days are noticeably shortening. It's time to buckle down to another year of studies and work. I hope everyone had a restful summer and are returning revived and rejuvenated. This is my second and final term as Treasurer for the Military Ordinariate.

For those that were able to attend the National Convention in Fredericton NB, there is still money left in the approved funding, and I am waiting for claim submissions. At this year's Military Ordinariate Convention, it was motioned and approved that we spend up to \$3,500 to send two accredited delegates and as many others as we could, to the National Convention in Fredericton. I know several ladies in the Maritimes were able to attend, and I have only received a few claims so far. We will reimburse the full expenses for our accredited delegates first, and then the registration fees for everyone else that attended. With the money that is left, travel expenses will be covered until we have spent the full amount authorized. If you went to the National Convention this year, you are guaranteed to get back your registration fee as an absolute minimum. The claim form is available in the Military Ordinariate CWL manuals, so please fill out a claim, attach your receipts, and send it to me as soon as possible.

Meetings will commence again in September, and this is a reminder to gather your volunteer hours for the entire council. Include all the time spent during the summer months in support of your communities. These hours are not strictly hours contributed to your parish; it includes hours donated to local service clubs and other community activities. These numbers are very valuable when our National CWL team represents our concerns to Parliament. The most accurate data is obtained by tracking the hours every month. Pass a paper around at each meeting to record the previous month's hours, and by the time the annual reports are due, you will have the data readily at hand. God bless your work and the year ahead.
